





Should first love be left in the past, or is first love, forever love...



'You can have it all,' they said. 'Happy children, happy marriage, great career – no problem,' they said...



Where will her loyalty lead her?



Alice Lang was wearing her favourite scarlet dress when she disappeared twenty-five years ago, and her memory still casts a long shadow.


