Can Belinda reconcile her emotions and find happiness once more in the place she so loved and called home?



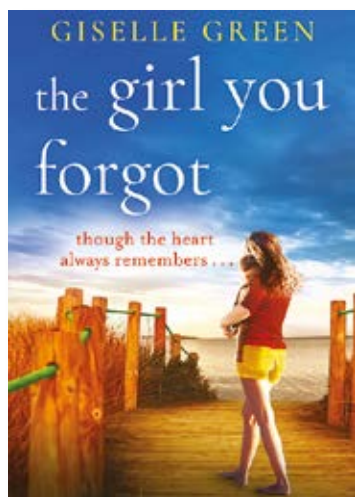

Does the heart never really forget?

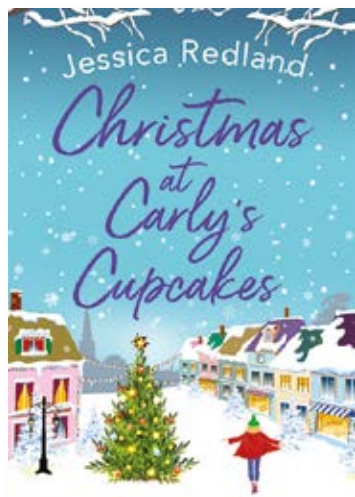

Could a little festive magic make all of Carly's wishes come true this Christmas...?

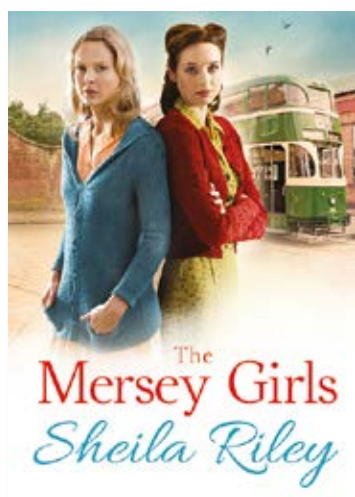

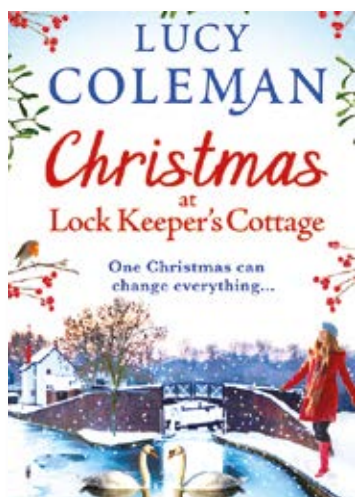
The Country Escape

Christmas at Lock Keeper's Cottage

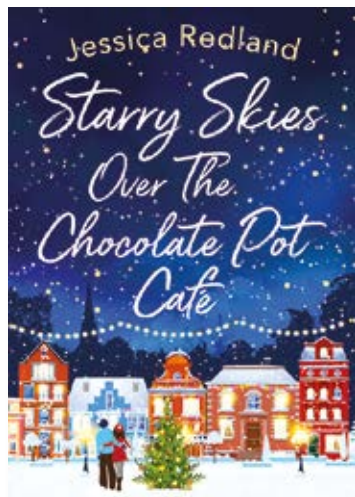

As the case progresses, DS Morgan realises she has a calculating, cold-blooded killer on her hands, and the race is on to track them down before they kill again.

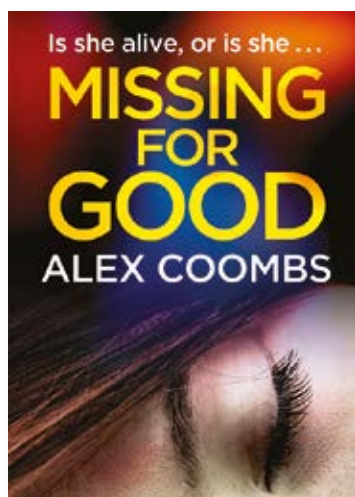

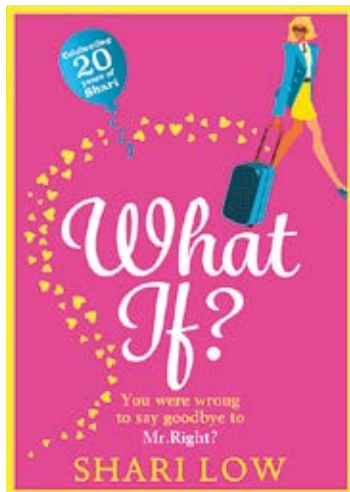
